Scholarship Program for ANA-PNNA-WCC Fall Seminar (Oct. 2018): COIN GRADING, PROBLEM COINS & CONSERVATION Scholarship Application

The PNNA is offering five full scholarships (for Adult or YN (Young Numismatist) collectors) to attend the Oct. 18-19, 2018 ANA-PNNA-WCC Seminar in Portland, "COIN GRADING, PROBLEM COINS & CONSERVATION," to be held at the DoubleTree Lloyd Center Hotel in Portland in conjunction with the PNNA/WCC fall convention. Some local coin clubs are also offering one or more scholarships to this seminar. Please indicate below if you are applying for a club scholarship.

Each scholarship includes ANA or PNNA member tuition for this class, a value of \$234. Transportation and lodging are not included. Membership requirements: All applicants must have either an ANA or a PNNA membership, to receive the member tuition rate. PNNA membership is required to apply for a PNNA scholarship, and club membership is required to apply for a club scholarship.

The winners will be Adult or YN collectors who meet the membership requirements, complete this application and are selected by the awards committee. *If you are not a current member of the PNNA – please submit \$10.00 PNNA dues with the application (\$5.00 YN dues). Please add \$5.00 to each dues classification if you want the PNNA's quarterly newsletter (The Nor'wester) mailed.*
